PE Kits

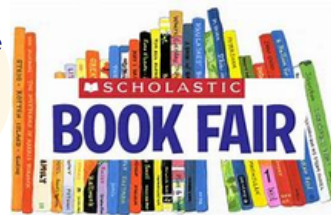
