PE Kits

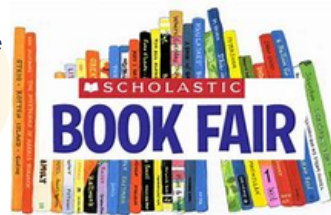
