It's a really busy week next week for LFPA

It's a really busy week next week for LFPA. Our results this year have been amazing and in all cases above national. It just proves that teamwork, determination and motivated children is the right combination. Phonics - 82% (up by 5% from last year) KS2 Reading - 78% (up by 16% from last year) with 22% at greater depth. KS2 Maths - 76% (up by 36% from last year) with 19% at greater depth. Our priorities next year are to develop the personal development area for the children so that they have more apportunities to access events and experiences through school. Attendance remains a priority as we are well under the national expectation for this. The Department of Education have published statutory guidance in relation to improving school attendance and our stance on attendance will follow this.
