## PE Kits

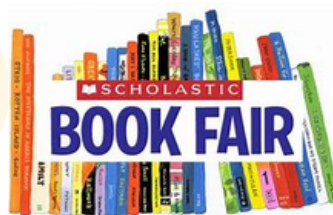
