PE Kits

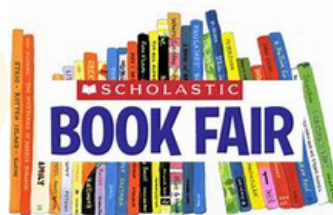
