Dogs on site

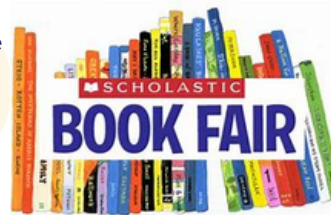
